Central is a two-year community college located in the beautiful and historically significant Wind River valley. A variety of distance delivery methods is available including Internet and live interactive video. Face-to-face instruction is also available at CWC outreach centers in Thermopolis, Dubois, Jackson, Lander and the Wind River Indian Reservation.

CWC offers more than 100 degree programs, about half designed to take the student to a transfer institution. The college's career and technical programs provide students with "real world" experiences, preparing them to go directly to work. Central offers a number of guaranteed scholarships to graduating high school seniors based on grade point average. There are also numerous activity scholarships for students involved in business, broadcasting, rodeo, art, music and theater.
