

2023 – 2024 COST OF ATTENDANCE INFORMATION SHEET

A cost of attendance (COA) is the estimated expenses a student may incur while attending CWC. The Department of Education has established guidelines that are followed in calculating allowable educational expenses. A student may only receive financial aid up to their estimated cost of attendance. The estimated cost of attendance is not the actual bill from the school. Each year, the financial aid office develops an estimated cost of attendance that takes into account inflation rates and economic adjustments for each component. For the 2023-2024 school year, the cost of attendance includes components for tuition and fees, books, course materials, supplies and equipment, housing, food, transportation, and miscellaneous personal expenses. Students who have accepted and are receiving loans a loan fee cost component is added to their cost of attendance. For students who are in Dental Assistant, Medical Assistant, ADN Nursing, and Computer Technology a cost component is added to their cost of attendance for the obtaining a license, certification, or a first professional credential. Listed below are the estimated cost of attendance components for this school year and are based on 15 credits for two semesters. The amount a student actually spends may vary depending on enrollment, academic program and living arrangements.

Although Nebraska isn't considered a WUE state, students are currently granted the same WUE tuition rate
